

# Using Images in Your Email Signature

You need to post your image to an online space somewhere that's visible for others. That is, you need a direct URL to the image online. Example: <http://i.imgur.com/FLmfj.jpg>

## Sites that Host Images

### The Most Centralized

The most centralized place would be Google Docs. This keeps your image as part of your GSU account.

- Go to Google Docs and click Upload Files
- Upload your graphic
- Open it and click the blue Share button
- Choose Anyone with the Link
- Copy that Link

### The Easiest

The easiest is probably a site called [imgur.com](http://imgur.com). It's free, requires no account, and will hold image file forever.

- Go to [imgur.com](http://imgur.com) and click the Computer button
- Select your file and choose Upload
- Copy the Direct Link in the right hand panel after it's uploaded. (See screenshots attached)



## Inserting the Image into your Signature

- Once you get your link, click on the Mail Setting link in Gmail and scroll down to your Signature
- Click on the Image icon and paste that link
